

Veberod Intermediate Silversmithing Classes

Congratulations on finishing the first two silversmithing classes! This gives a brief description of some of the classes you can take as you get comfortable using your torch. Check the current schedule online to see what is available in the next few months. If you are really hoping for a specific class and its not on the schedule check with Tai and maybe she can fit it into the next schedule. No room at home? Rent an Open Studio bench in the new classroom for \$25 on most Friday nights to practice your newly acquired skills. **Cancellation:** Most advanced classes are \$85-\$95 plus materials and require payment in advance. 3 BAND ROLLING RING

This ring is made with three interlocking bands. Because they are not soldered TO each other, they roll over each other, creating a unique movement. Texture bands if desired. Prerequisite: Silversmithing 2



KUEM BO EARRINGS

Apply high karat gold foil to your sterling silver pieces and learn how to work with Keum Bo pieces. You will design a project with your Keum Bo to finish on your own. Prerequisite: Cold Connections 1, SS2.



STACKABLE RINGS

Practice your soldering and bezel setting skills in this fun ring class. This set makes a great gift, and is fun to make again and again, giving you confidence. Great to take before SS3 Prerequisite: Silversmithing 2.



DESIGN W/ SILVER SCRAP

This class is designed to do two things- teach you exquisite torch control, and give you a way to use your scraps to make whimsical, organic pieces. You may embellish to your skill level Prerequisite: Silversmithing 2



FUSED/WOVEN CHAIN

Make a complete bracelet by fusing fine silver wire links, then weaving them into a chain. The assembled chain is then drawn to even it out and a custom hook clasp is added. Prerequisite: Silversmithing 2.



FABRICATED BANGLES

Experiment with using the rolling mill to change wire in many different ways while we play with effects created by twisting wire (and more). Then we turn our experiments into bangles. Prerequisite: Silversmithing 2.



IVY VINE NECKLACE

This is another interesting chain style that can be made by beginning silversmiths. A torch is used to create the balls and the curved links create a botanical look. Prerequisite: Silversmithing 2.



SOLDERED POST ERS

Practice your soldering skills as you attach posts to a variety of earrings. One option is these classic bezel set stud earrings. Prerequisite: Silversmithing 2.
