Intermediate Prong Setting

Learn cut your own seats in un-notched prong settings, which will allow greater flexibility for setting non-calibrated stones and cutting seats in setting you fabricate.

Please plan to provide all your own consumables, including burs. You will be able to purchase anything you need at Veberod Gem Gallery during class EXCEPT settings, which must be pre-ordered. **Being able to see clearly is essential to your success, so bring any portable lighting and magnification you have (cheaters, OptiVisor, Telesight).**
Prerequisite: Silversmithing I, Beginning Prong Setting

Supplies Required

Faceted oval or round stones, 5mm-15mm
Matching UN-notched settings
(MUST be pre-ordered)

Tools used

Variety of Setting Burs
Variety of 45 degree Hart Burs
Needle files, square and barrette, #2 and #4
Cup Burs
Prong Lifter
Caliper
Chain Nose or flat nose Pliers
Magnification-REQUIRED
Portable Ott Light



Notes on tools/supplies

This list is designed to help you determine what to bring from home. Not everything is required, and we **STRONGLY** recommend not buying anything before class if you don't already have it. Many times there are factors that will determine your best choice and we will discuss all this at class. Bring what you have, and don't stress about what you don't.

We prefer not to offer kits for our classes. We try to encourage students to pick equipment and supplies (stones, beads etc.) based on their individual creativity. Often there are several options available and you may have some items already.
